Department	Methodology used for experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies
Economics	<p>The Department organised several engaging sessions and activities to promote experiential learning, participative learning, and problem-solving methodologies. These included a research paper writing session led by Ms. Surily Sahay, a discussion on global economic issues and India's G20 presidency with Dr. Sanjaya Baru, and various activities related to G20 priorities. Ecolligence 2023, the annual fest of the Economics department of PGDAV college featured a talk by an eminent economist, invited and contributed research paper presentations and a debate competition. Additionally, a short-term certificate course on 'Data Analysis Using R' was offered for beginners with no prior knowledge of the R programming language. These initiatives provided diverse opportunities for students to learn through hands-on experiences, participation, and problem-solving activities.</p>
History	<p>The Department of History organised a series of academic events to enrich students' learning experiences. The Paper Presentation competition, 'Monologue,' explored how cinema influences the representation of Indian history, encouraging experiential and participative learning. The 'Fact Hunt' quiz competition tested historical knowledge about polity, society, and social movements from 1850 to 1950, promoting interactive learning and problem-solving. A talk by Prof. Makkhan Lal shed light on preserving historical accuracy and highlighting unsung heroes, fostering critical thinking. Additionally, a one-day National Seminar focused on the significance of the Tomar and Chauhan Rajvansh in Delhi's history, promoting research and knowledge exchange. These events collectively contributed to a well-rounded educational experience.</p>

<p>Mathematics</p>	<p>One Day National Workshop On Vedic Mathematics was organised by the Department of Mathematics, P.G.D.A.V. College (M) in collaboration with Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas on 30th August 2022. The workshop was organised on this useful and interesting topic at the time when Vedic Mathematics has become a part of the NEP syllabus. Teachers were trained and motivated for the forthcoming Vedic Mathematics VAC paper under NEP 2022. Department also organised counselling sessions for students of the college. The session was regarding JAM, the IIT entrance exams. Speakers shared their wisdom and expertise with students, practical tips and strategies that students can use to prepare for these exams, including how to manage their time effectively, the importance of practice tests, and how to stay motivated throughout the process.</p> <p>On the 13th of April the Anant Mathematics Society, organised its annual Inter-College mathematics fest, Spectrum 2023, where they celebrated the spirit of learning and creativity. The event consists of a series of fascinating mathematics games.</p>
<p>Statistics</p>	<p>The Statistics Department of P.G.D.A.V. College organised its annual festival “SKEWSION’23” on 11th April, 2023, which included a range of activities such as invited talk by prominent statistician, paper presentation competition, chess competition, statistics guessing quiz and anime quiz. The event was aimed at providing a platform for students to showcase their skills and talents in various fields, as well as to gain knowledge through invited talk.</p> <p>Prof. Anish Sarkar from the prestigious Indian Statistical Institute, Delhi delivered a talk on the topic “From Real world to Statistical world” He provided valuable insights on how to apply theoretical knowledge to practical situations.</p> <p>Young Researcher’s Forum, a paper presentation competition was held in which students from various colleges/ universities presented their research papers on topics related to statistics, mathematics, computer science and economics. The competition provided a platform for students to showcase their research skills and encouraged them to think critically.</p> <p>Simultaneously, Battle of kings- a chess competition, Taboo De Statistica- a statistics quiz, Otaku’s rumble-an anime quiz, was held in the event.</p> <p>The event was an excellent opportunity for students to engage in various brain-stimulating activities and further their academic and professional growth.</p>

<p>Environmental Science</p>	<p>The department of Environmental studies engages its students through various student centric methods including lectures, powerpoint presentations, interactive sessions, photographic and video graphic illustrations, field activities, laboratory practicals, powerpoint presentations, group discussions and project submissions by the students. The department actively organises international/national seminars, lectures, workshops and interactive sessions with the field experts The department works extensively in creating environmental awareness among students through the Environmental society Geo-crusaders and observing environmentally important days through organising subject related competitions, talks, workshops, quizzes, debates and other related activities. Our department imparts a wide array of skills to the students ranging from soft skills to prospecting, E-waste mining, food waste and by-product utilisation to promote the concept of sustainable living, circular economy and urban mining. Hands-on training is provided to students to segregate and manage their household waste through composting, prospecting e-waste as a valuable resource through laboratory practicals. The students are trained to make valuable products such as vermicompost from garden waste, bio enzymes from food waste, incense cones from flower waste etc. in the college premises. Our students also actively participate in organising waste paper collection drives and have conducted training sessions at NGO Shakti Shalini and at MCD South Zone office through their outreach programs under ENACTUS chapter to make upcycled products to earn their livelihoods.</p>

Abstract

Economic activities have developed and been carried out in this advanced era which is associated with the negative impacts on our environment and climatic changes. Such impacts have led the governments, nations and organizations operating globally to come forward and focus on 'Green Growth'. **But how can government pause these negative impacts on the environment and promote 'Green Growth'?** India has been developing, starting from the mid-1980s but at the cost of its environmental degradation like any other country in the world. **This research paper inspects the steps being taken by India towards green growth by analyzing the budget for 2023-24.**

The research paper will get insights into how the budget for 2023-24 aspires to the conservation of natural resources and biodiversity of the nation. The world is facing the problem of a growing population at the rate of 1.1 % per year or 83 million approx. per year (*World Population Prospects 2017, UN*). India's population is growing at the rate of 0.81% in the year 2023 becoming the most populated country in the world overtaking China's population. India owns only 2.4% of the total land available while supporting the population of 17.85% of the total population in the world which is 8 times its actual land size available making it difficult in near future to support such a large population. Hence, resulted in the significant destruction of existing limited natural resources to a large extent and put pressure on the environment. Preventive measures for the natural resources and environment from the existing risks is what, which gave rise to the term "green growth" when agreed upon by international organizations and nations unanimously.

What is Green Growth?

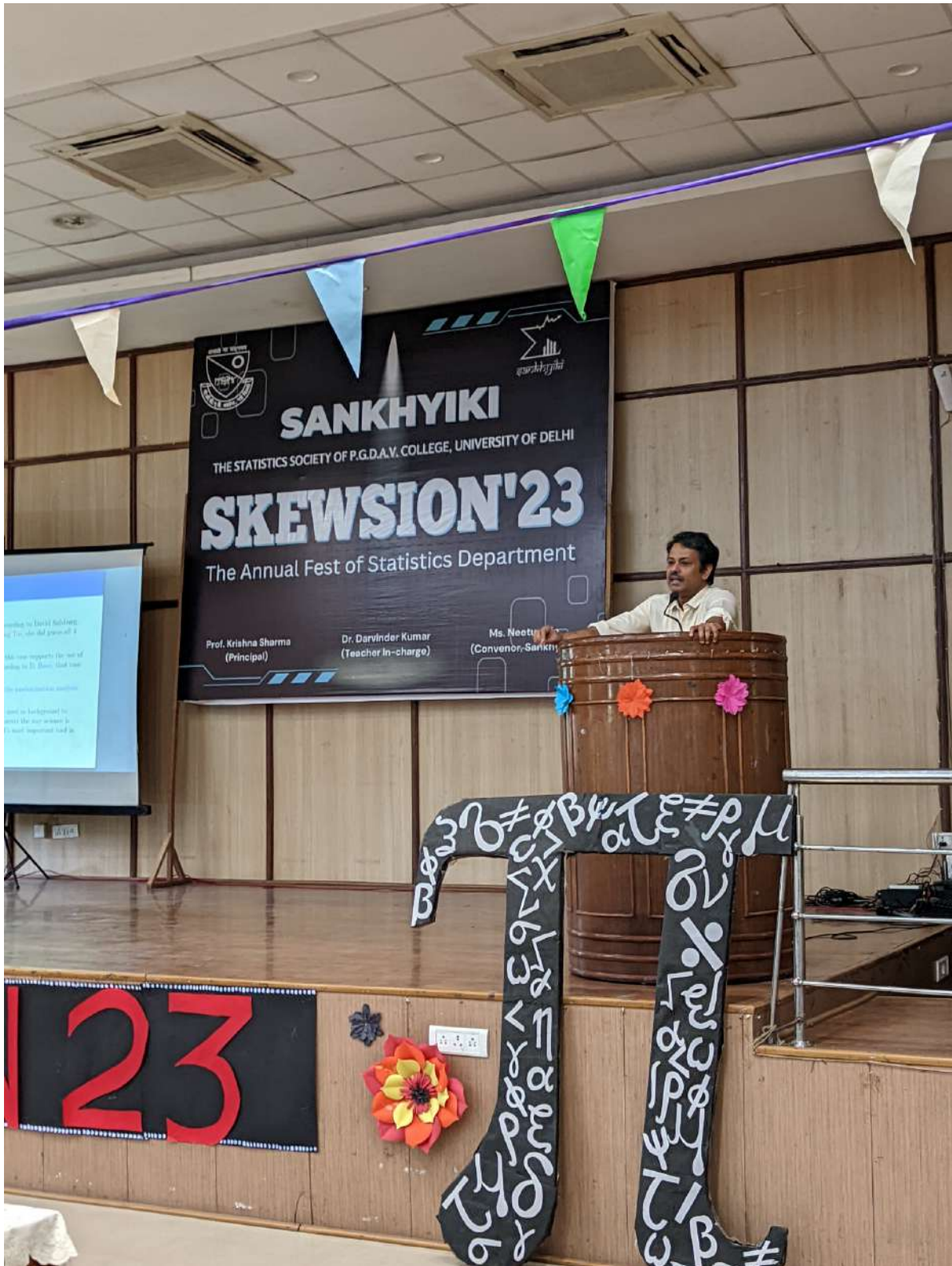

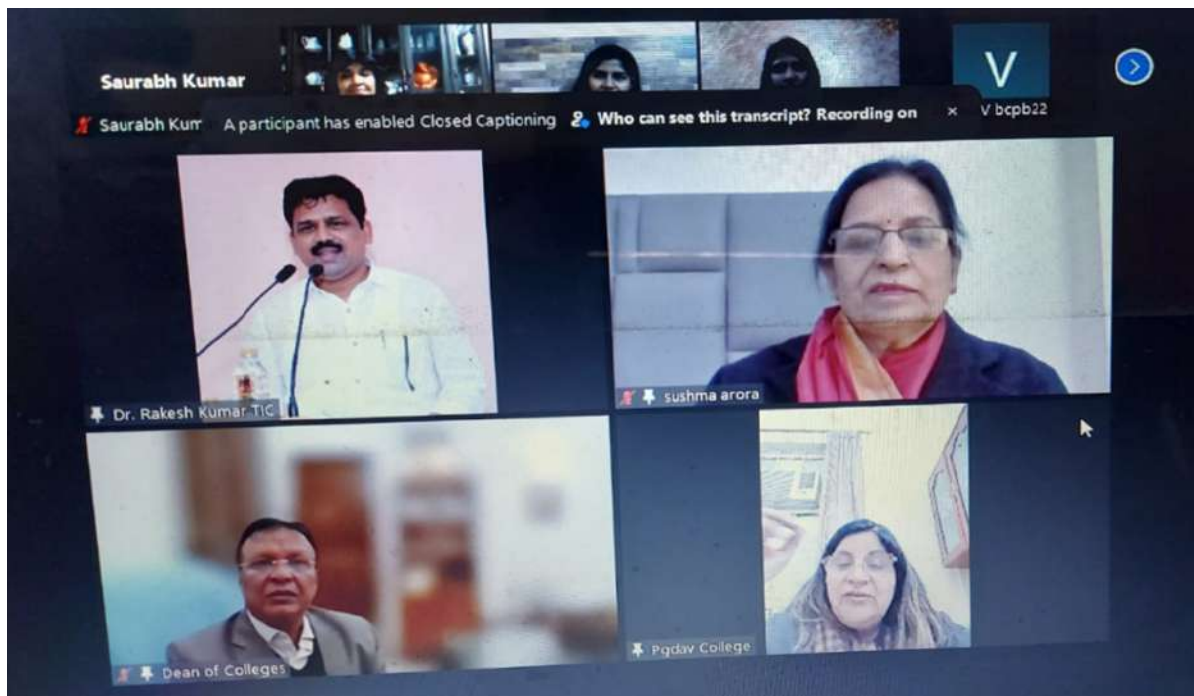

- An offer must contemplate to give rise to legal consequences.
- Terms of the offer must be certain and not loose or vague.
- It must be communicated.
- An offer cannot prescribe silence on the part of other party as acceptance
- Offer may be general or specific
- Offer may be express or implied
- Offer may be positive or negative
- Offer may be definite or standing offer/tender.
- Offer may be conditional
- Communication of specific terms
 - ✓ Must be communicated before or at the time of formation of contract
 - ✓ Accepts correct placed literacy
 - ✓ Extremely unreasonable conditions can't be held binding
- Two identical cross offers do not make a contract.
- An invitation of offer is not an offer

Illegal agreements

According to Section 23, every agreement of which the object or consideration is unlawful is void. And object or consideration is unlawful in the following cases:

1. if it is forbidden by law
2. if it is of such nature that if allowed, it would defeat provisions of any law
3. if it is fraudulent in nature
4. if it involves or implies injury to a person or property of another
5. if the court regards it as immoral

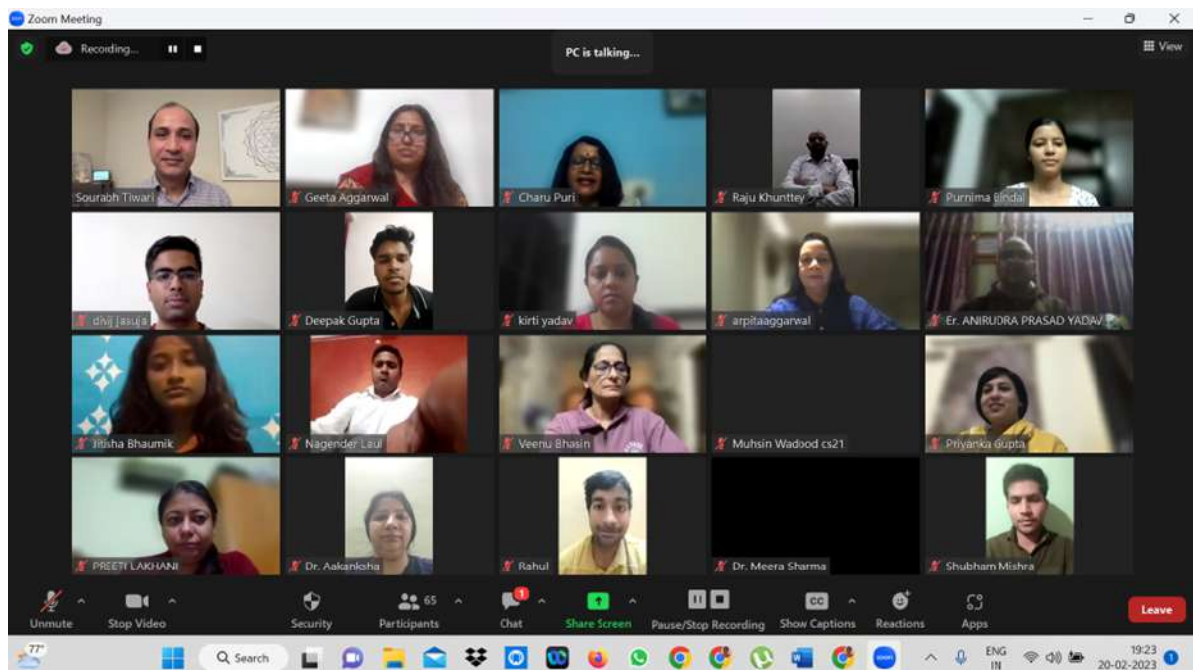
