SALIENT FEATURES OF THE INDIAN CONSTITUTION
The Main Features of Indian Constitution are:-

- The Constitution of India was created by a Constituent Assembly and not by the Parliament of India. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was the Chairman of the Constituent Assembly and he is called the Father of Indian Constitution.
- The Indian Constitution contains 395 articles and 12 schedules, making it the world's longest written constitution.
- Article 167 of the Indian Constitution deals with the powers of Parliament to amend the Constitution and its provisions.
- There are 35 articles and more than 100 amendments have been added. However, since the articles are not added separately but as part of an existing article, the total number of articles remains the same i.e. 395.

FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES
According to Indian Constitution, it shall be the duty of every citizen of India:

- to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag, and the National Anthem;
- to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our reformers, viz. Truth, Non-Violence, and Fraternity;
- to vote and to stand for candidates for election to any office who are qualified to stand for election;
- to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India.

OUR MOTTO -

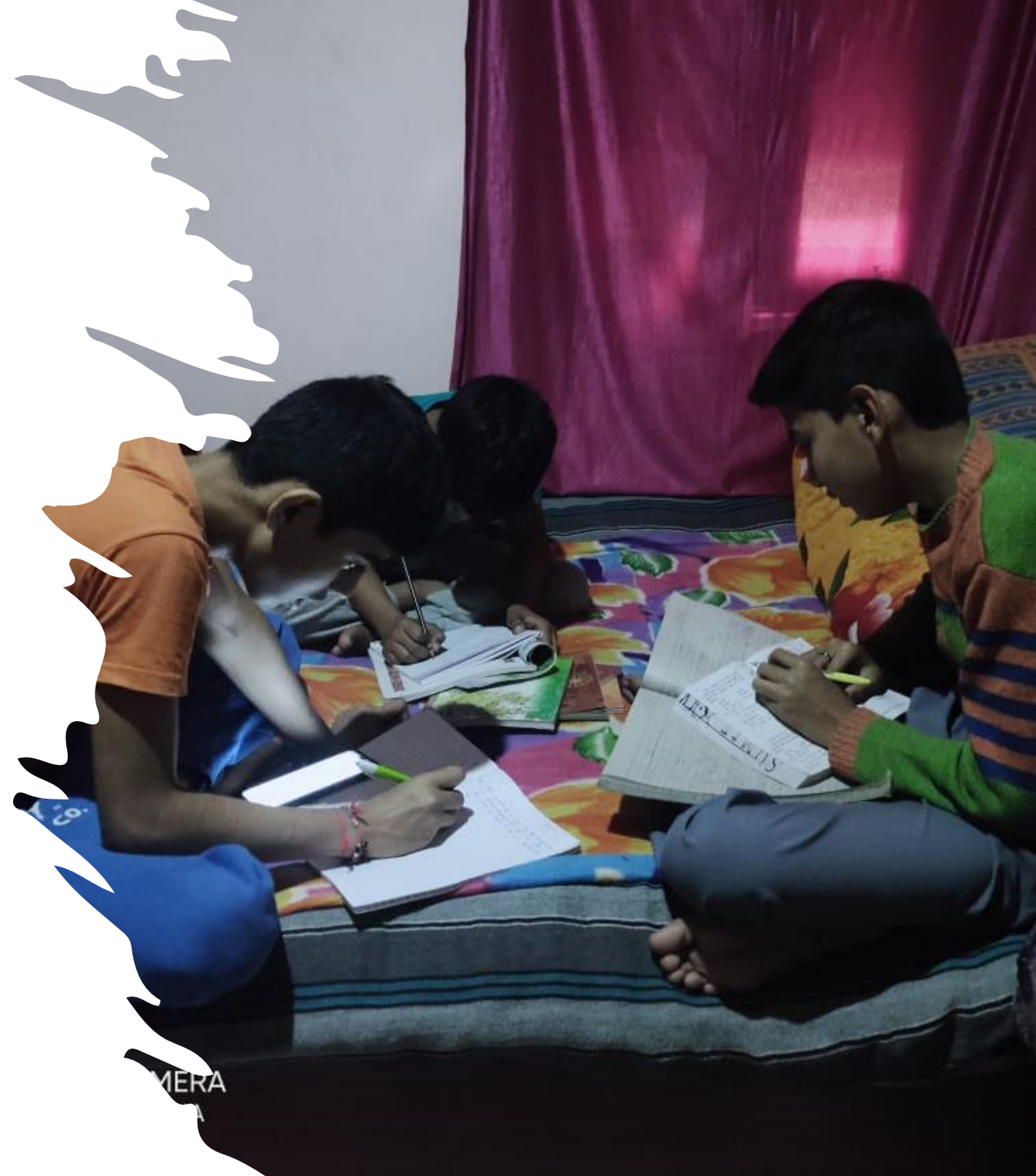

3. FIT INDIA FREEDOM RUN 2.0 (CELEBRATING 75 YEARS OF INDIA'S INDEPENDENCE)

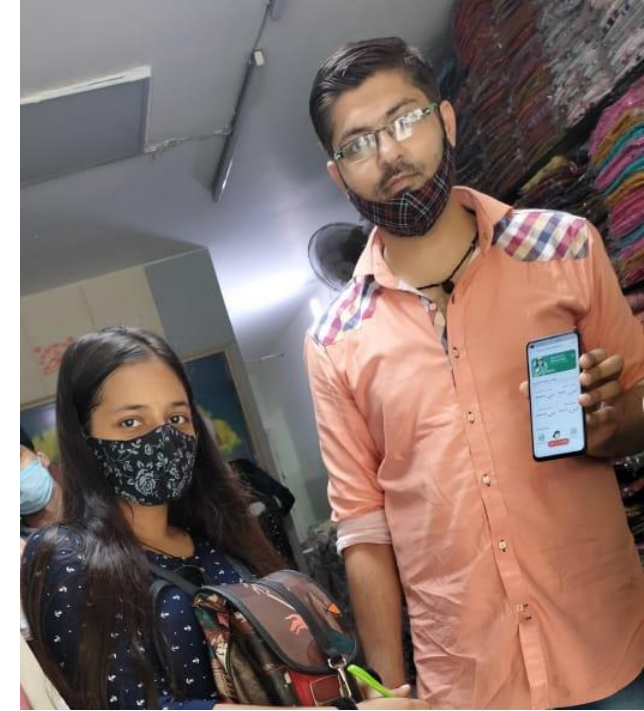

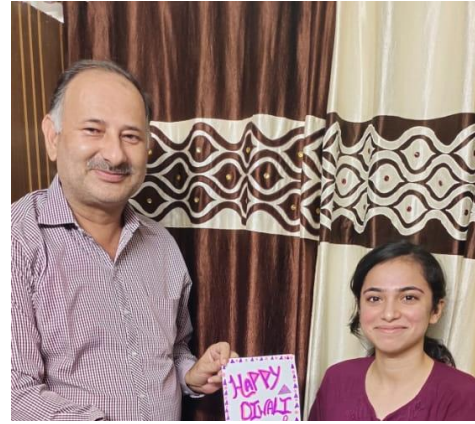

10. Woollen cloth donation drive

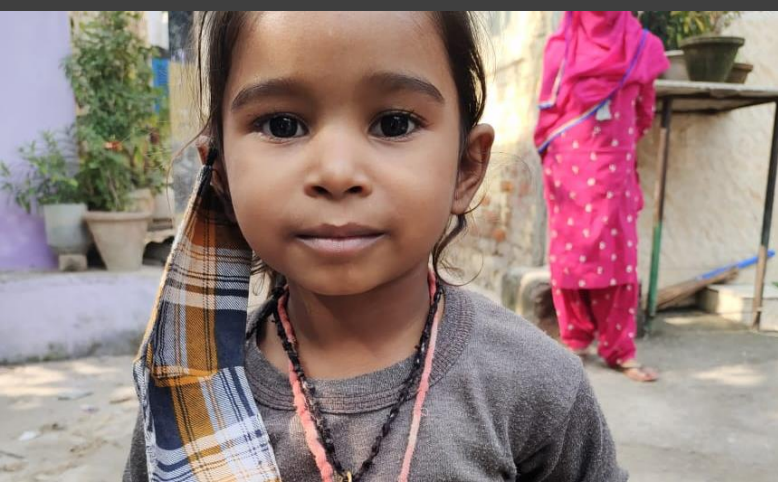

Our team ensured the smiles on the pretty faces of women who live in slums and also taught them about women's related government schemes.

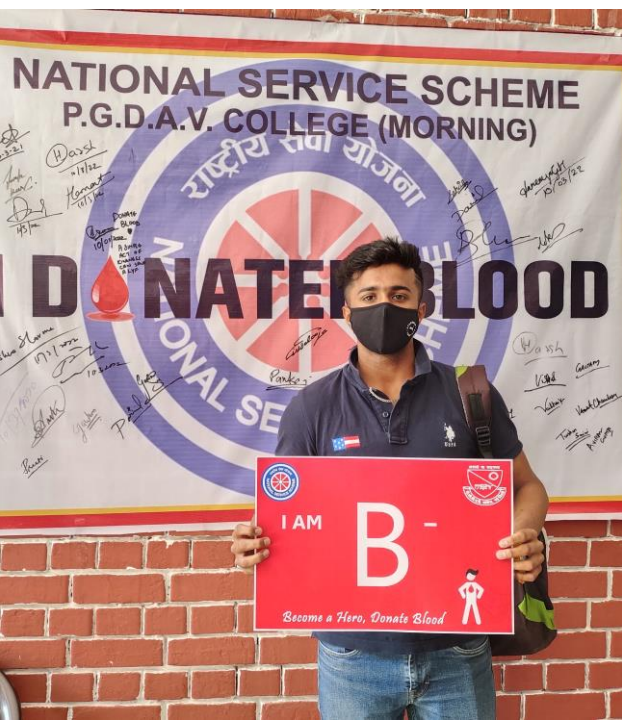
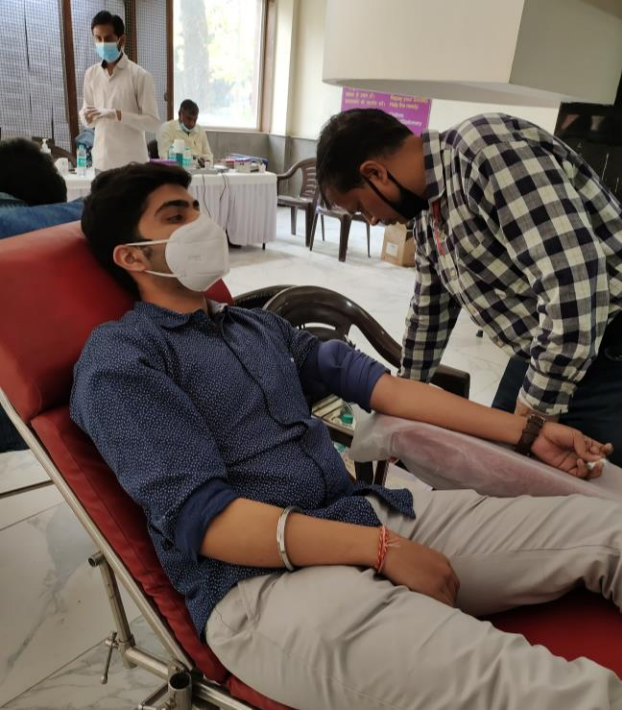


15. Lecture on Women Empowerment: A Heart-to-Heart Talk on occasion of Women's Day

The people of the village were very hospitable and cooperative and helped us in completing the survey. The survey revealed that most of the People in the village work in unorganized sector and have studied till 12th and only fistful number of people have received higher education but the positive response was that the people of the village know the value of education and they want that their children to be highly educated and they also agreed to sent their girl child to the library for study but perturbed about their security. In some families, the women were more educated than men.

The youth's and children's eyes were glittering with a lot of dreams but what they lack is how they will achieve their dreams. A library at such a place will add an edge for villagers to fulfilling their dreams and also conducive environment for the study will also be created in the village.

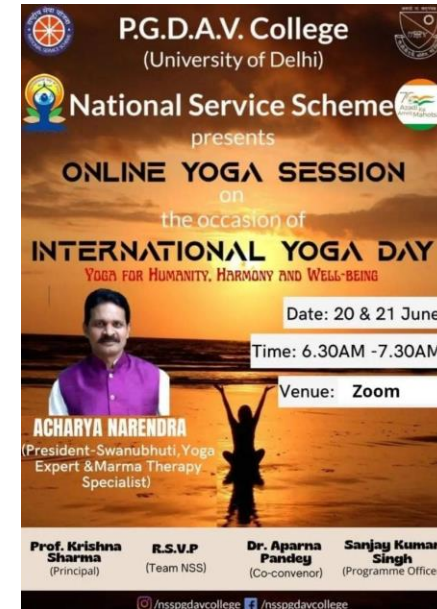
DAY 1 of Online Yoga Session
