The mission of Geo-Crusaders; The Environmental Society, is to create awareness and motivate students towards the conservation of environment and sustainable utilization of natural resources. The major activities conducted by Geo-Crusaders in the year 2021-2022 were-

### **EARTH DAY- 2021**

**Earth Day**, an international event celebrated around the world to pledge support for environmental protection. The year 2021 marks the 51st anniversary of the annual celebrations. This year's theme for Earth Day was 'Restore Our Earth'. This year's theme focuses on natural processes, emerging green technologies, and innovative thinking that can restore the world's ecosystems. In 2009, the United Nations designated April 22 as 'International Mother Earth Day'. "Recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic is a chance to set the world on a cleaner, greener, more sustainable path," said UN Secretary-General António Guterres in a statement. On this great occasion a **webinar** was organized to create awareness where **Dr. Binota Thokchom**, from **Manipur University**, delivered a lecture and motivated the students. "Mother Earth is clearly urging a call to action. Let's remind more than ever on this International Mother Earth Day that we need a shift to a more sustainable economy that works for both people and the planet. Webinar was attended by around 100 participants.

### **INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY, 2021**

Society observed **International Day for Biological Diversity** on May 22, 2021 at 11AM. It was an online **One Day International Seminar** on the topic "**We're part of the Solution**". The Seminar was graced in the presence of renowned figures in their respective fields, our **Chief Guest Prof. Dinabandhu Sahoo (Prof, Dept of Botany, University of Delhi)**, the **Guest of Honour Dr. Ram Karan (Research Scientist, UAE)** along with our **Special Guest IFS Ankit Kumar (ACF, Khellong Forest Division, Arunachal Pradesh)**. The seminar was attended by more than 450 people on the online platform along with the members of society.

The seminar started with Prof. Sahoo talking about Biodiversity for Everyone's life. He explained how the biodiversity crisis affects everyone and not just one in particular. He described it as the web of life. He emphasised that biodiversity underpins the health of the planet and has a direct impact on all our lives. He also pointed on a few technicalities like ecosystem service, food security etc. Moving forward with the seminar, our Guest of Honour, Dr. Ram Karan took us to the possibilities of Life on Mars. He spoke about various evidence

of life on mars and how this could be the future of the human race. He made us familiar with the situation of extremophiles on mars and their evolution. In the end hours, Our Special Guest, IFS Ankit Kumar explained about the biological diversity of orchids in India and how Ecotourism is a part of the solution. He spoke about various species of orchids and their availability in India and why or how orchids are important to biodiversity. He also highlighted the importance of ecotourism in our country and more ecotourism destinations shall be planned.

## WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY- 2021

Society organized One Day **International Seminar** to celebrate **World Environment Day** on June 5th 2021, at 5 pm with the theme of **"Ecosystem Restoration"**. Our Chief Guest was Prof. Radhey Shyam Sharma (Dept. of Environmental Studies, University of Delhi) and Guest of Honour Ms. Anali Bustos (Ph.D. University of Buenos Aires, Argentina). The seminar was attended by more than 200 people. It was a very knowledgeable and interactive session too that made it a grand success.

Our speakers spoke about the theme of the day. Ecosystem restoration means preventing, halting and reversing this damage – to go from exploiting nature to healing it. Ecosystem restoration is a global undertaking at a massive scale. It means repairing billions of



hectares of land – an area greater than China or the USA – so that people have access to food, clean water and jobs. It means bringing back plants and animals from the brink of extinction, from the peaks of mountains to the depths of the sea. But it also includes the many small actions everyone can take, every day: growing trees, greening our cities, rewilding our gardens or cleaning up trash alongside rivers and coasts. Restoring ecosystems carries substantial benefits for people. For every dollar invested in restoration, at least seven to thirty dollars in returns for society can be expected. Restoration also creates jobs in rural areas where they are most needed.

## INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR PRESERVATION OF OZONE LAYER, 2021

We organised a **National Seminar** with **Dr. Ram Pravesh Kumar** (Asst. Prof., School of Environment Studies, JNU) on the occasion of **International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, 2021** on Sep 16<sup>th</sup> 2021. This informative session had an active participation of about 230 people.

Dr. Ram Kumar familiarised us with the concepts of ozone layer, preservation and the harmful effects if not taken care of. The ozone layer, a fragile shield of gas, protects the Earth from the harmful portion of the rays of the sun, thus helping preserve life on the planet. The phaseout of controlled uses of ozone depleting substances and the related reductions have not only helped protect the ozone layer for this and future generations, but have also contributed significantly to global efforts to address climate change; furthermore, it has protected human health and ecosystems by limiting the harmful ultraviolet radiation from reaching the Earth.

The GEO CRUSADERS organised yet another **One Day National Seminar** to celebrate **National Pollution Control Day 2021** on Dec 2nd at 3PM. **World Water Day- 2022**

### **1st International Virtual Conference:**

Department of Environmental Studies, PGDAV College, University of Delhi in collaboration with Mohanlal Sukhadiya University, Udaipur, Rajasthan & Young Social Scientists Association of India (YSSAI), organized two days 1st International Virtual Conference on **"Living With Ecological Balance: Life Style, Economy, Environment & Sustainability"** on the 10th and 11th of July 2021. The speakers for the day were Prof D.S Rajput (Ex HOD, Dept. of Sociology, Dr. H.S. Gour University, M.P, India) along with Prof. Tanu Jindal (Director- AIETSM, Amity University, U.P.) and Dr. Karan Singh (Research Scientist, NYUG School of Medicine, Dept. of Cell Biology, New York, USA). The event witnessed the participation of nearly 500 participants.



The speakers made us aware of the benefits of Ecological Prosperity and its Recent contributions to ecological economics and related social sciences indicate that issues such as climate change, resource depletion and environmental degradation cannot be effectively addressed under conditions of continued economic growth. Building on the growing literature that interprets prosperity 'beyond' economic growth, they presented a three-dimensional concept to operationalise prosperity in terms of *ecological sustainability*, *social inclusion*, and the *quality of life*. In order to achieve a decent minimum of prosperity moderate levels of the material living standard are sufficient. Further increases in the material living standard do not lead to significant additional prosperity; instead they cause greater environmental harms. The speakers concluded by highlighting potentials for prosperity for each of the 'prosperity regimes' and corresponding policy challenges.

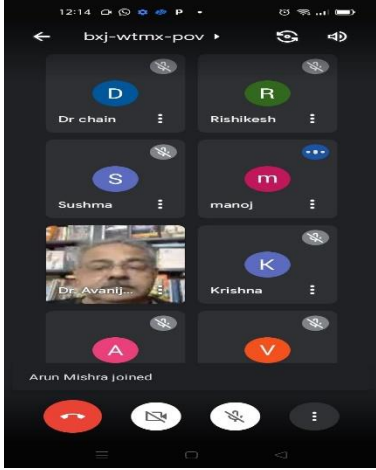
## **Report on Short-term Certificate Course on 'Data Analysis using R'**
