Lecture

The College in collaboration with IQAC organised a lecture on the topic "Sarkari Kamkaj mein Hindi ka Prayog". To promote Hindi language in various governmental works this lecture was organised on 10th May 2023. The Chief-Guest Shri K.P. Sharma, Deputy Director, Department of Official Language, threw light on importance of Hindi language and creation of national identity through language. One of the goals of Amrit Kaal is to evolve with sustainable technology and focus on research and innovation to make India one of the developed nations. We are also emphasising on vernacular language for teaching in the National Education Policy 2020 which has been introduced nation-wide during our celebration of 75 Years of Independence since India is a multilingual Nation. However, since Hindi is the most widely spoken language and identifies us as a unified country it is important that official works are also done in this language. Since British period and even presently English has been a common binding language in all official works it created a gap between people adept in English and those who couldn't understand the language. For inclusive growth and partnership in development of the country Hindi language is being promoted by the Government and therefore this topic was selected to make students and teachers and non-teaching alike aware of the utility of this language.
