One Day National Seminar

The Department also organised a one- day National Seminar in collaboration with ICHR and Akhil Bharatiya Itihas Sankalan Yojana on 22nd Feb. 2023 on the topic 'Tomar evam Chauhan Rajvansh ke antargat Gauravshali Dilli'.
