





पीजीडीएवी कॉलेज में रहेगा विद्यार्थियों के लिए विशेष फंड

फीस भरने में असमर्थ छात्र-छात्राओं को मिलेगा लाभ

नई दिल्ली, (पंजाब केसरी): कोरोना की दूसरी लहर ने सभी को प्रभावित किया है। ऐसे में बीते साल से छात्रों की पढ़ाई ऑनलाइन माध्यम से जारी है। डीयू के पीजीडीएवी कॉलेज (प्रातः) ने कोविड से प्रभावित जरूरतमंद विद्यार्थियों के लिए विशेष फंड का प्रावधान किया है। इसके चलते कॉलेज स्टाफ अपनी इच्छानुसार आर्थिक मदद दे सकता है। पीजीडीएवी कॉलेज (प्रातः) की प्राचार्या प्रो. कृष्णा शर्मा की देखरेख में यह पहल की गई है। यूं तो हर बार कुछ छात्र आर्थिक कारणों से फीस भरने में असमर्थ होने पर फीस माफ या छूट देने का अनुरोध करने आते हैं, लेकिन कोरोना में अनेक छात्र-छात्राएं और उनका परिवार प्रभावित होने से अछूते नहीं रहे। प्रो. शर्मा ने बताया कि कॉलेज स्टाफ के साथ कोरोना की स्थिति को देखते विचार विमर्श कर विशेष फंड रखने का निर्णय लिया गया, जो कि जरूरतमंद छात्र-छात्राओं की फीस भरने में ही इस्तेमाल किया जाएगा।




