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### 1. Introduction

In light of this overarching mission, the institution places immense significance on gathering input from its stakeholders, particularly the students.

The feedback received from the students serves as a vital mirror reflecting the true quality of the teaching-learning process. It offers an avenue for identifying the strengths of the teaching staff while also highlighting areas that have potential for improvement. This feedback-driven approach helps the institution refine its methods and ensures that the educational experience remains in alignment with the evolving needs and expectations of its learners.

### 2. Methodology

In the academic year 2021-22, a dedicated feedback committee took the initiative to conduct a comprehensive Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS). This survey was designed to gauge the overall performance of the institution and gather valuable insights from the student body. The feedback committee meticulously crafted a questionnaire that covered various aspects of the college's performance. This questionnaire was then made accessible to all students via the institutional website. To ensure maximum participation, the students were notified through notices, social media groups, Google Classroom, and other relevant platforms. The survey was conducted through an online interactive mode<sup>1</sup>, providing students with a convenient and accessible way to share their feedback. The approach was successful in encouraging participation from a diverse range of students enrolled in different courses across the institution. The survey process was concluded with a noteworthy level of engagement, resulting in a substantial volume of responses from the student community.

The inputs collected through the Student Satisfaction survey provide a comprehensive view of the student perspective regarding the institution's overall performance during the academic year 2021-22. This feedback serves as a crucial foundation for making informed decisions and implementing targeted improvements in various aspects of the institution's functioning. The diligent efforts of the feedback committee have ensured the successful execution of the Student Satisfaction Survey. The institution greatly values the participation and contribution of its

students, as their insights are instrumental in shaping the continuous growth and development of the college. The forthcoming sections provide a detailed analysis of the survey's findings, shedding light on the students' perceptions of the institution's overall performance in the academic year 2021-22. The following report aims to present a comprehensive overview of these findings and the subsequent steps that the institution intends to take based on the feedback received.

Moreover, to conduct a systematic and scientific analysis of the student satisfaction survey on the overall performance of the institution, a rigorous approach was taken to convert students' responses into quantifiable measurements. The questionnaire consisted of a diverse set of questions, each addressing different aspects associated with the institution's overall performance. To ensure fairness and appropriate comparison, a uniform scale was devised. In this regard, the student responses, which were initially presented as percentages, were normalized to a common scale using a range of 0 to 4. The purpose of this normalization was to create a consistent basis for evaluating responses across all questions. The following formula was applied to calculate the normalized score for each question:

Normalized Score=((Student Percentage Response) ×(scale for option))/100

This formula allowed the conversion of student responses into a scale that ranged from 0 to 4, facilitating direct comparison between different questions. The normalized score provides a numerical representation of the students' sentiments on various aspects related to the situation's overall performance. By applying this normalization process, the institution aimed to systematically analyse the survey results, ensuring that all responses were evaluated on a standardized scale. This approach enabled the identification of trends, strengths, and areas for improvement based on the quantifiable data derived from the student satisfaction survey. The subsequent sections of the report will delve into the specific findings obtained through this analysis and outline the implications for enhancing the institution's performance.

### 3. Analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey


The following are the observations of student satisfaction survey feedback on overall performance of the institution.

- Syllabus Coverage: 82.7% of students indicated that more than 85% of the syllabus was covered in classes.
- Teacher Communication: 80.4% of students agreed that teachers effectively communicate in classes.
- Teacher Preparation: 93.9% of students agreed that teachers are well-prepared for their classes.
- Teaching Approach: 93.3% of students revealed that teachers have a highly effective approach to teaching.
- Students' strengths and weaknesses identification: 82.8% of students felt that teachers identify their strengths and weaknesses and encourage them appropriately.
- Bilingual Instruction: 75.2% of students agreed that teachers use bilingual instruction in class.
- Extra Time for Queries: 69.9% of students reported receiving extra time from teachers and mentors to solve their queries.

- Opportunities for Learning: 60.9% of students agreed that the institution provides various opportunities for learning and growth.
- Academic Seminars/Conferences: 93.2% of students agreed that academic seminars and conferences are held regularly.
- Soft Skills Development: 84.9% of students acknowledged efforts to include soft skills, life skills, and employability skills.
- Extra-Curricular Activities: 81.3% of students reported that the college organizes and encourages participation in extracurricular activities.
- ICT Tools: 69.7% of students agreed that teachers use adequate ICT tools in the classroom.
- Internal Evaluation Fairness: 71.5% of students thought that the internal evaluation process by teachers is fair.
- Administrative Staff: 88.8% of students agreed that the administrative staff is courteous and cooperative.
- Library Resources: 87.2% of students agreed that the library has sufficient books and journal subscriptions.
- Library Support: 88.7% of students agreed that the library staff provides good support in locating books.
- Computer Lab Facilities: 75.2% of students agreed that the college maintains adequate computer lab facilities.
- Hostel Staff: 57.9% of students agreed that the hostel staff is cooperative.
- Sports Facilities: 63.2% of students agreed that the college has adequate sports facilities.
- Drinking Water: 82% of students agreed that the drinking water facility is suitable.
- Canteen Food: 90.2% of students agreed that the canteen serves hygienic food at a reasonable cost.
- Photocopying Facilities: 92.2% of students agreed that photocopying facilities are available at a reasonable cost.
- Medical Room: 58.6% of students agreed that doctors in the medical room are usually available and cooperative.
- Website Information: 94.8% of students agreed that the college's website provides adequate and well-organized information.
- Security and Safety: 85% of students agreed that the security staff is adequate and cooperative, and 71.6% felt safe on campus.
- Greenery on Campus: 97% of students agreed on the presence of sufficient greenery on the college campus.
- Nation Building: 81.9% of students agreed that the college contributes adequately to nation-building.
- Overall Teaching-Learning Quality: 94.8% of students agreed that the overall quality of the teaching-learning process is very good.






2. How well were the teachers able to communicate?






4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 133 responses




5. The teachers identify your strengths and weaknesses and encourage you by providing right level of challenges.




6. The teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes in advance.




7. Do you agree that teachers are bilingual in class? 133 responses




8. Do you agree that teachers and mentors give you extra time to solve your queries? 133 responses




9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow by promoting internship, placements, field visit opportunities for students and in other ways. 133 responses



10. Do you agree that academic seminars and conferences are held regularly in the college? 133 responses






12. Do you agree that the college organises extracurricular activities and encourages you to participate in them?




13. Do you agree that your teachers use adequate and necessary ICT tools in the classroom? 133 responses



14. What do you think about the fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers? 133 responses




15. Do you agree that the administrative staff is courteous and cooperative? 133 responses




16. Do you agree that the library has sufficient books on syllabus and subscription to necessary journals?






18 Do you agree that the college maintains adequate computer lab facilities?133 responses




Do you agree that lab staff is cooperative?


20. Do you agree that the college has adequate sports and fitness facilities? 133 responses




21. Do you agree that drinking water facility is suitable? 133 responses




22. Do you agree that the canteen premises are neat, and hygienic food is prepared in the canteen? 133 responses




23. Do you agree that the canteen food is available at reasonable cost? 133 responses



24. Do you agree that photocopy facilities are available at reasonable cost ? 133 responses




25. Do you agree that the doctors in the medical room are usually available and cooperative? 133 responses





26. Do you agree that the information on the website of the College is adequate and well-organized?




28. How safe do you feel on campus?133 responses








30. Do you agree that college contributes adequately for nation building? 133 responses

The analysis based on normalised score indicates that on a scale of (0 - 4), the learners reveal their satisfaction to a great extent with the average score of 3.683. Further analysis reveals that for the majority of the questions, the learner responds with the score greater than 3.
